

# Why chats were removed

Certain chats had to be removed for reasons you find below.

## Identical chats

Sometimes, both (or more) communication partners sent in the same chat.

Example: Anna sent in a chat with Peter containing 219 messages from either communication partner. When Anna asked Peter to give his permission to use his texts, he enjoyed the idea and sent in some of his chats as well. One of them was the chat that he had with Anna. Because he sent the chat in at a later date, the chat now contained 252 messages. In this case, we removed the chat sent in by Anna (because it is shorter) but kept the chat sent in by Peter.

## No permission

Some informants sent in chats but never gave the permission to use them.

## No text

Some chats were sent in without any text, i.e. they were very short and contained only URLs or videos or pictures.
